We will also have ManxBirdLife visiting Reception to talk about birds on the Island and we will be making some ball feeders to put on our school grounds. As well as this, we will learn about Christmas and Advent, the traditions and how we celebrate these special events. Each week we will have a story or book that we will base our learning around.
