### Costume Design

### Our Big Ideas:

Throughout our Create Project, we will be looking at the following elements of art:

Line: A distinct straight or curved path that represents a 2D or 3D object.

Shape: An area enclosed by a specific number of straight or closed lines.

Colour: Artists use colour to create emotional impact/feelings. There are three building blocks to colour; hue, value and intensity.

Texture: This is the way something feels or looks. Texture can be created to look how it would feel.
