<u>Summer 1 Half Term:</u> Welcome back, after a rather wet Easter break, to the beginning of the third and final term of the school year!

<u>Uniform:</u> As we are now in the summer term, polo shirts can be worn in the juniors. No ties are required to be worn with the polo shirt. School shorts can be worn by all pupils. <u>Reports:</u> Your child will receive an end of year report next half term. Details of new classes and teachers will also go out with reports. If you need to speak to your child's class teacher at any point, please phone or email the office to make an appointment.

Sports Day: On Wednesday 29th May we will be having Sports Day. During the morning, house teams will complete their obstacle races to collect house points for their team. During the afternoon the whole school will compete in running and egg and spoon races and parents are invited to watch.
