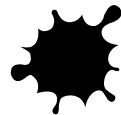


Our Create Project in Year 6 is...

Street Art



To answer our question of 'Should we always do as we're told?', we will be exploring the art of Graffiti and Street Art. Throughout our Create Project, we will be looking at the following elements of art:

Line: A distinct straight or curved path that represents a 2D or 3D object.

Colour: Artists use colour to create emotional impact/feelings. There are three building blocks to colour; hue, value and intensity.

Texture: This is the way something feels or looks. Texture can be created to look how it would feel.

Form: When a shape acquires depth and becomes three dimensional it takes on form.
