
Our Project in Year 4/5 - How can we make our mark?

They will be using their new skills to design and create their own tote bag, using a print of their choice to reflect their individuality.




Collograph Printing




Lino-Printing

Helen Trevisiol Duff


A British artist and printmaker known for her textured and mixed-media collography of birds, landscapes and architecture.
