

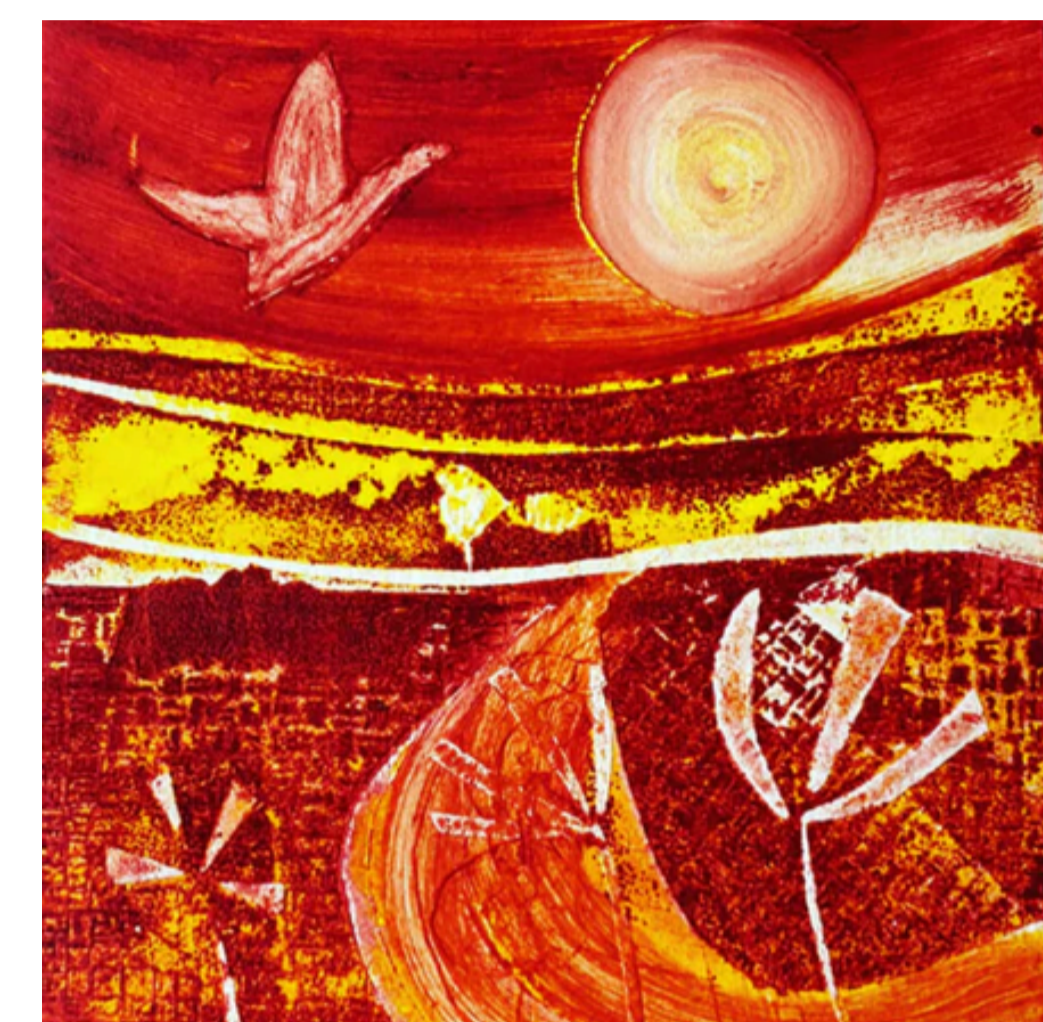
# Our Project in Year 4/5 - How can we make our mark?

Throughout our create project, we'll be looking at the following elements of art:

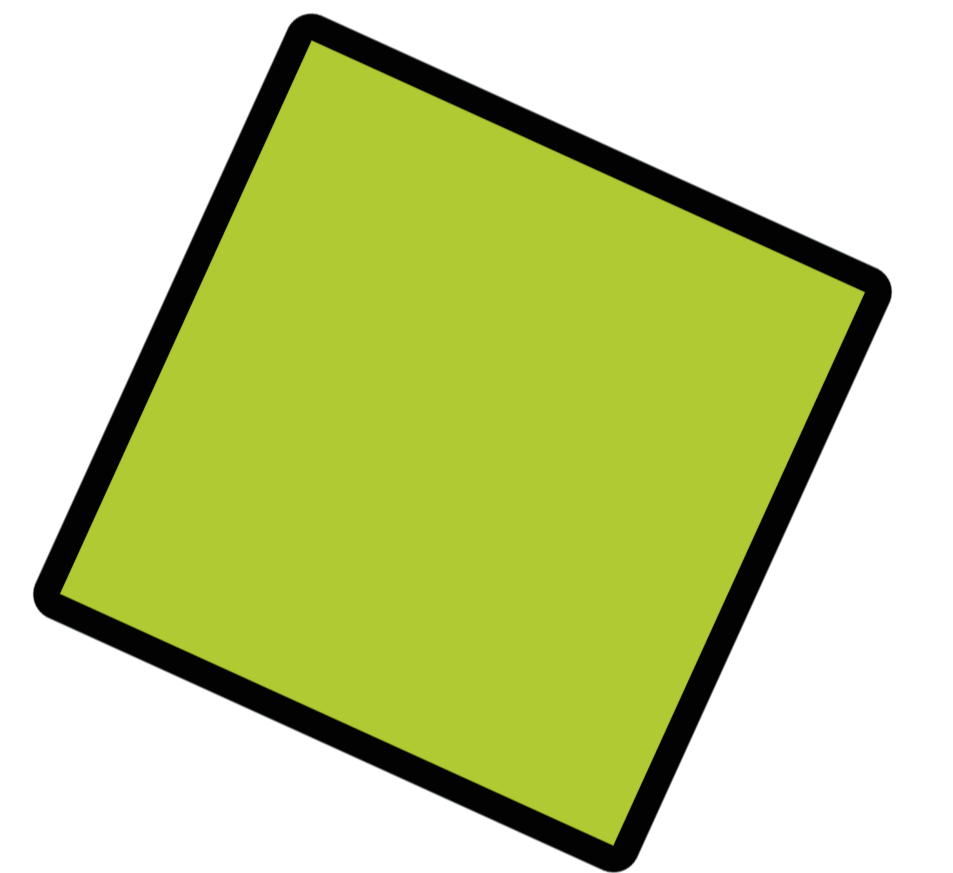


Line

A Swiss-German artist known for his bold and vibrant mono-printing that expressed emotions through colour and form.



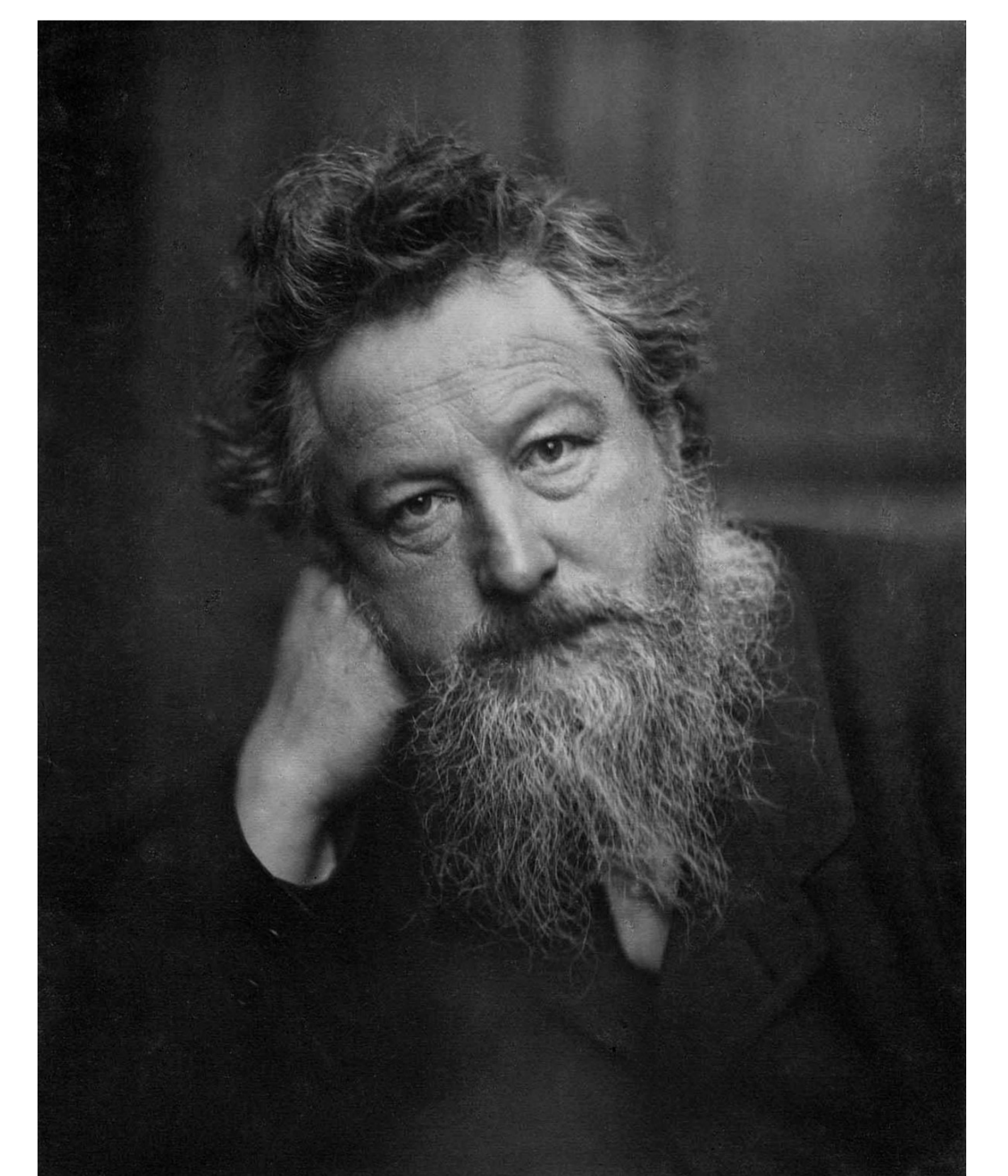
## Helen Trevisiol Duff

## Swimming Slots

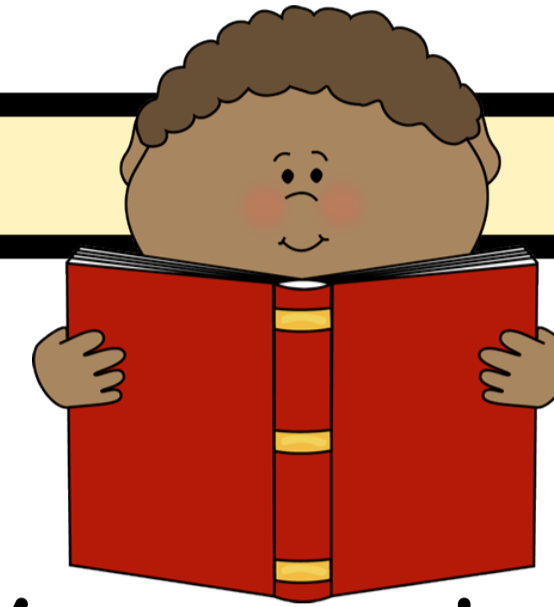
Swimming will be on a Wednesday morning. Please ensure children have a correct kit with them each week.

- Earrings and watches will need to be removed.



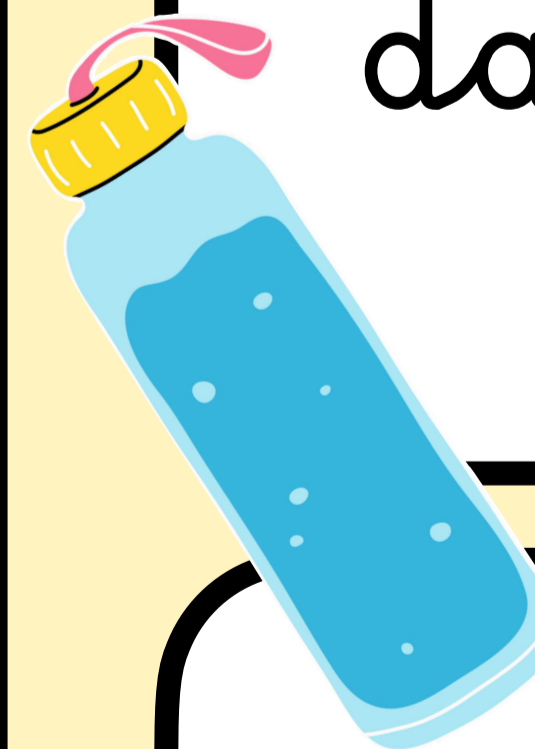
## Reading

## Water Bottles / Snack

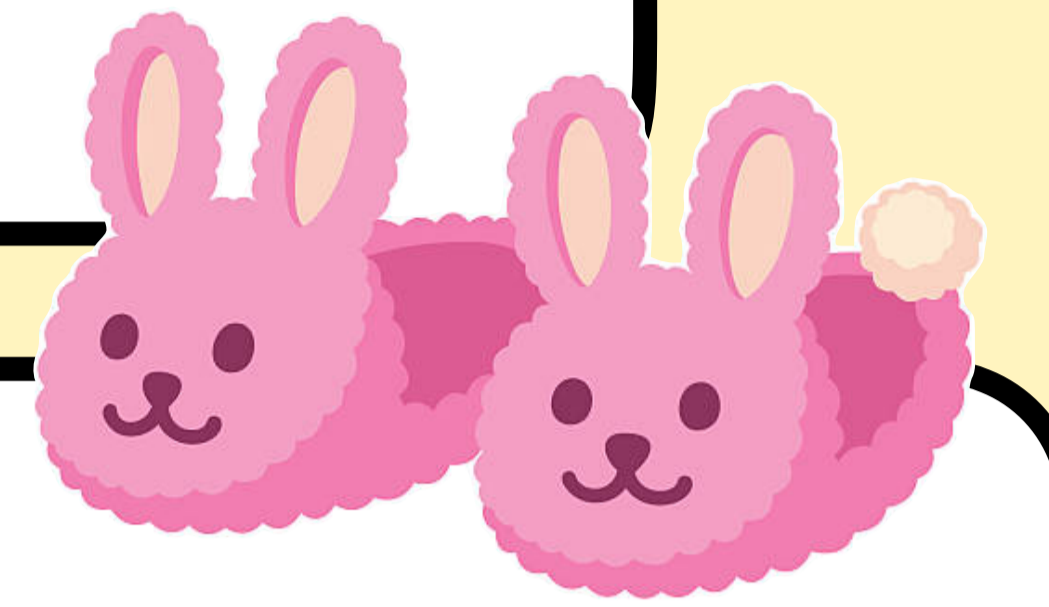
Please ensure your child has a named and refillable water bottle in school each day. Snack can be eaten during 1st play.
