What is STEM Fest?

An event which will showcase the Isle of Man STEM Sector and the wide variety of career choices that are available. Students will take part in a large range of interactive and fun activities in each zone which help them to produce or experience a STEM related process.

Who is organising STEM Fest?

The event is being organised by the ACE (Awareness of Careers in Engineering) Steering Group, a branch of the Engineering Committee of the Chamber of Commerce & employed.im.

Members of STEM industries and the Department of Enterprise, Department of Infrastructure and the Department of Education, Sports & Culture are also supporting the event.
