Victorian movie

Using our key concepts and big ideas, children will be creating a short movie to showcase their learning journey about the Victorian era. We will be zooming in on everyday life in Victorian times, as well as zooming out to explore wider historical events through timelines and significant moments in history.

Throughout this project, children will investigate important questions such as “**What is a Queen?**”, “**What is an Empire?**”, and “**What does Reign mean?**” They will also develop their historical inquiry skills by examining evidence and learning to distinguish between **primary and secondary sources**.

Evidence: Primary and Secondary sources as the two main types of historical evidence.


Similarities and Differences: Understanding the extent of similarity and difference between sorts of people - and between people within the same group
