## TOWERS, TUNNELS AND TURRETS

#### LITERACY

Focus - Reported Speech and Letter Writing.

Our first piece of writing will be focused on Reported Speech. Through exploring the traditional fairy tale of 'Rapunzel', children will take on different character roles. We will work towards creating newspaper interviews of the different characters,

After this, we will be focusing on Letter Writing. We will be exploring the different features we need to include when writing a letter of complaint to the Board of Fairy Tales.

Children will continue with their phonic sessions and extra independent reading when possible.

#### PE

Focus. - Defend and attack games; Balance and co-ordination.

We will explore a range of different 'tactics' to aid attacking/defending in team games, while also developing our ability to move over, under and through spaces and obstacles outdoors.



Focus - Getting on and Falling out.

This half term, we will be focusing on developing our skills in three key areas: empathy, managing feelings and social skills.

#### MATHS

Focus - Addition and Subtraction, Money, Statistics.

We will be adding and subtracting numbers mentally and showing that the addition of two numbers can be done in any order, but subtraction cannot.

We will be exploring money to recognise and use the symbols for pounds  $(\pounds)$  and pence (p). Through this, we will be finding different combinations of coins that equal the same amount of money.

We will learn to interpret simple pictograms, tally charts and tables. Through this we will be able to ask and answer questions based on the data.

Focus - Animals and their Habitats

This half term we will be looking at animals and their habitats. We will be classifying living and non living things. We will be looking at how animals adapt to suit their habitats. We will be investigating micro habitats in Noble's Park! Finally looking at food chains - producers and consumers.
