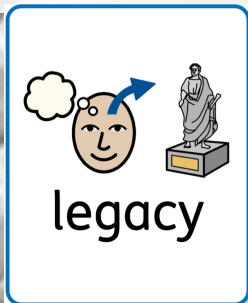


Our 'Create' project enquiry question is...

Leaving something behind for people to remember - good or bad...



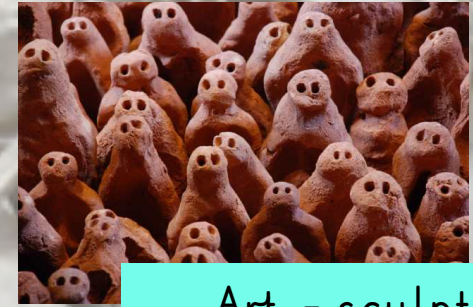
The idea or reality of feeling or being truly free.

Our RE learning will explore the journey of God's people from slavery to freedom. This will include considering the 'Laws we live by' and how we determine the best way for us to live in PSHE.

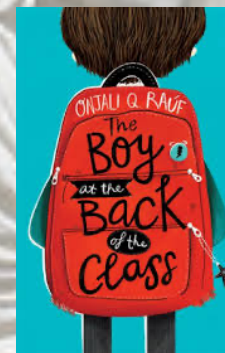


Art - sculpture
