Literacy:
NARRATIVE - Oranges in No Man's Land
Speaking and Listening

The children will use a range of oral techniques to present persuasive arguments and engaging narratives. Participate in whole-class debate using the conventions and language of debate, including standard English.

Reading
The children will appraise a text quickly, deciding on its value, quality or usefulness. Understand underlying themes, causes and points of view. Understand how writers use different structures to create coherence and impact

Writing
The children will set their own challenges to extend achievement and experience in writing. Reflect independently and critically on their own writing and edit and improve it. They will use different narrative techniques to engage and entertain the reader. Select words and language drawing on their knowledge of literary features and formal and informal writing

Big Write
Each week we have a big write this begins with a talk and planning session where the children are given a stimulus for their writing. We then have a calm writing session. This is followed by constructive marking and feedback.

P.E. & Games:
The PE topics for this term will be:

Science Topics: Our current science topic is interdependence and adaptation, we will look at how plants and animals adapt to their habitats, food chains and photosynthesis.

We will be completing a historical task from St Ninian's High School where we will be producing a detailed timeline of events from the Thirteenth and Fourteenth Century.

The children will continue to follow our ICT curriculum. They will be independently developing the skills they learnt earlier in the year on the Computer Bus.
We will continue to explore the importance of e-safety.
